3. Woodland Adventure Birthday Party

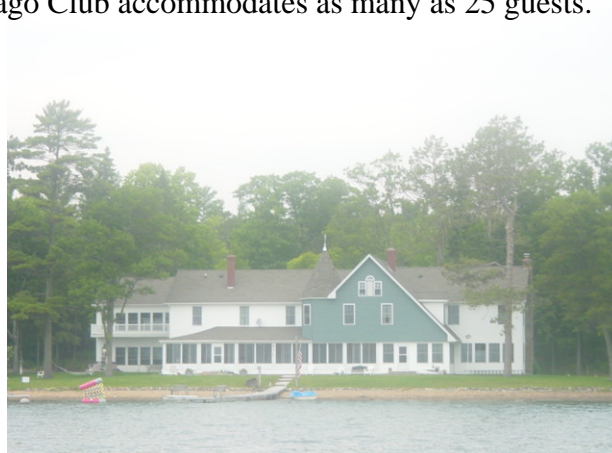
